

We want to thank the Class Representatives, who via What's app are able to disseminate important circulars, address urgent questions and keep all within their group well-informed of events information relevant to their class and year.



#### What we have raised

It has been an excellent year of fundraising and support enabling us raise a whopping £4,659.98 between September to December 2023.



We raised a fantastic £10,544.87 during the period February to August 2023 which proved to be an excellent academic year.

The combined total for period February to December 2023 is £15,201.85. We thank you so much for your support.



## The Wish List

Here is how the money raised so far has helped Edward Betham. Our school is no different to many schools in the Borough, where needs are a priority. We, EBFA are pleased to confirm that we have been able to help grant those wishes and have supplied the school with £11,654.81 to acquire the following;-

- ✓ Fiction and non-fiction books for Junior Department
- ✓ English EYFS, Maths, Music, History and Special educational need [SEND]
  books
- ✓ Seasonal gifts for each classroom
- ✓ Computing Kidizoom

Our Committee is currently made up of 14 members who dedicate their time on a voluntary basis.

































#### **Notices**




# Easyfundraising.org.uk
